The Zionist Federation of Ukraine (ZFU) was formed in December 2001 by Vaad of Ukraine and is based on the principles of the Jerusalem World Program of the World Zionist organization.

Since January 2017, the organization has been of cially registered in Ukraine and conducts independent program activities.

Acknowledging and accepting the Jerusalem program, rst of all, the ZFU coordinates its activities with the following principles:

- the unity of the Jewish people and the central place of Israel in Jewish life;

- the reuni cation of the lewish people in its historic homeland -Land of Israel;

- strengthening the State of Israel, which is based on the prophetic vision of justice and peace;

- preserving the identity of the Jewish people through development Zionist upbringing and education in Hebrew and Yiddish, as well as Jewish spiritual and cultural values.

The main goals and objectives of the Zionist Federation of Ukraine are full assistance and promoting unity to the Jewish community of Ukraine, approval and realization of the right of lews - citizens of Ukraine - to their own identity and national culture, improving the image of the Jewish community in the Ukrainian society, the development of Ukrainian-Jewish and Ukrainian-Israeli relations.

In Ukraine, there are many Zionist parties and movements represented. The main focus of ZFU today is on intercommunal youth, educational and cultural programs.

In the summer of 2015 and for the rst time in the history of the Jewish community of Ukraine, the elections of delegates to the 37th



Zionist Congress, which took place in Jerusalem in October 2015, had been held. As a result, seven delegates from ve parties represented the Jewish community of Ukraine at the Congress.

In 2018, the Zionist Federation of Ukraine (ZFU) continued to strengthen and expand its activities. New programs were opened, and already existing ones continued and expanded their work.

The program of the Hebrew Speaking Club "What's about to talk?!" has been running since 2016.

Thanks to the support of the Dutch Humanitarian Fund, the World Confederation of United Zionists (CUZ) and Vaad of Ukraine signi cantly succeeded in expanding of the work of the Club.

In addition to Kyiv club of ces, the new ones were opened in Chernivtsi, Melitopol, Vinnitsa and Kropivnitsky. Also of the Hebrew Speaking Club opened online platform.

Over three years of work, its own style and original technique of holding meetings have been developed. This program is the rst on the territory of Ukraine and represents natural continuation of learning in ulpan. Club meetings are held in the form of conversation on a pre-de ned topic. Most Club meetings devoted to Jewish tradition, Jewish holidays and community events.

A special place in the work of the Club is occupied by meetings with people who have high Hebrew level. Native speakers were invited There were Ron Gar eld – the head of the Ukrainian JAFI branch; Dima loffe - the head of the repatriation department of Ukrainian Branch of JAFI; a traveler, a businessman Ram Rosenfeld; the creator of the falafel diners' network in Ukraine Guy Dotan; the director of the community of traditional Judaism Michal Stamova; the director of the Center for Jewish Education of Ukraine Natalia Bakulina; the creators of the Israeli community of local lore museum «Meeting Place» Anna and Meir Antopolsky and others.

The creation of the Hebrew Speaking Club helped the majority of its participants not only to improve their conversational Hebrew, but also to nd like-minded people, to gain new knowledge about the Jewish tradition, Jewish lifestyle, to participate in Jewish holidays, etc.

The program has played and plays an important role in uniting members of the Jewish community. The club continued its work in 2019.

### Organized by the ZFU in early 2018, the program "Interesting meetings" involves holding meetings, lectures, presentations on various topics of Jewish life.

**On March 20, 2018,** a meeting was held with Anna and Meer Antopolsky (Israel), the founders of the Israeli meeting of local lore society "Meeting Place". The main topic of discussion was how life ows on so-called "Israeli territories" and how it is possible, necessary and dif cult to establish relations with the Arab neighbors, how the club "Meeting Place" was created. Also, we talked about the need, all the possibilities and dif culties of climbing the Temple Mount. The event included the presentation of Meir Antopolsky's book "Guide to the Temple Mount" in Ukrainian.

**On April 19, 2018,** a meeting-lecture with the chief editor of J-News magazine Mila Lerner on the topic "Jewish media in Ukraine" took place.

**On June 6, 2018,** a lecture was held with the Executive Director of the World Confederation of United Zionists (WZO), Marketing Manager of Argus Cyber Security Ltd., Jesse Sultanik «How do Israeli innovations affect solutions of world problems».

**On August 29, 2018,** the presentation of the book of Sviatoslav Bakis "Cinema in the Jewish Lens" - a collection of reviews of Ims related to the Jewish theme. Reviews have been published in the Hadashot newspaper from 2012 to 2018. The publication of the book is a project of the Vaad of Ukraine.
